Death Takes Mrs. Annie Gardner Stephens

Mrs. Annie Gardner Stephens passed away at her home on North Main Street. She was born June 6th, 1842, in Gordon county, was married to Mr. Simeon Stephens in 1884, and was a twin sister to the late Mr. Joshua Gardner.
