Charles "B" Stephens, 87, of Davis Drive, Cartersville, died Friday, Oct. 16, 2009.

Mr. Stephens was born Oct. 28, 1921, in Bartow County, the son of the late John Ben Stephens and Bunia Cordia Floyd Stephens. He was a member of the First Congregational Methodist Church.

"B" was a veteran of the U.S. Army Air Force. He served in Normandy, France and England during World War II and was the recipient of six Bronze Stars.

His life centered on his love for God, his family and his church. As a charter member of the First Congregational Methodist Church, he assisted in the construction of the church, taught Sunday School and served on the Board of Stewards.
