

## Henry G. Stephens Dies After Illness

Henry G. Stephens, 73, retired painter, died at the residence, 611

E. 2nd St., Rome at 6:30 a. m. Wednesday following an illness of one year.

Mr. Stephens was born in Gordon County, Dec. 19, 1882, son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Holland Stephens. He made his home in Rome and Floyd County for the past 35 years, going there from Bartow County where he resided for 40 years. Mr. Stephens was a member of the First Christian Church of Adairsville.
